Neuright, Inc. was just awarded STTR funding from the National Science Foundation and is **looking to hire a part-time staff member to work from our office in Orono and liaise with the research team at UMaine** in order to facilitate the goals of this award.

The ideal candidate will have comfort with basic scientific/administrative duties such as ordering and communicating with vendors, maintaining records (including in the Microsoft Office Suite and Adobe software platforms), and should it be necessary, be capable of working remotely. In addition, a basic level of R&D knowledge will be required to assist with data presentations and reports in collaboration with the research team and company leadership. Strong oral and written communication skills as well as organizational skills are also required.
